Please mark your calendars for three upcoming events. All are invited to attend the Forward in Faith Celebration Banquet on Saturday, June 2nd. No donation and no


pledges will be requested. Enjoy a delicious dinner, music and surprise speakers.

Reaching Our Goals - Making Our Vision A Reality!



We're at that point when each of us will be encouraged to offer financial commitments to our campaign. As we draw closer to making our commitments to resource the vital needs of our church, you are invited to celebrate this opportunity to serve God.

Our campaign is about more than just finances. We have the privilege and opportunity to carry forward the legacy of our facilities and realize God's vision for us here. Here are the ways you can make your commitments to our campaign.

Sunday, June 3: Commitment Worship Services

The Joy of Generosity in Scripture

How many times do we all tell ourselves that our lives would be significantly better if we just bought something—a new car, a new home, etc.? In Scripture, we learn the joy that comes from generous giving, rather than through the accumulation of things or the abundance of material possessions. In 2 Corinthians 8 and 9, the apostle Paul makes it clear that the Corinthian people's giving to the church in Jerusalem is just as important to their own spiritual welfare as it is for the physical welfare of the Christians in Jerusalem. Paul emphasizes three important concepts:

1) Give voluntarily, give joyfully, and give first to the God. “God loves it when the giver delights in the giving!” (2 Corinthians 9:7b)

2) Give proportionately as God has blessed you. Our campaign is not about everyone giving the same dollar amount, but about everyone expressing an equal level of generosity based on their particular circumstance and household income.

3) Trust in God. “God is able to provide you with every blessing in abundance, so that by always having enough of everything, you may share abundantly in every good work.” (2 Corinthians 9:8)

Please prayerfully consider how you can give joyfully and generously to the ministry of Westminster. Remember the words of Jesus, “Where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.” (Matthew 6:21)
